BOOK FAIR - FAMILY EVENING

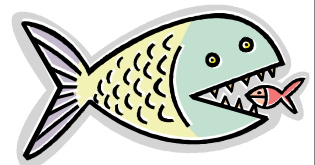
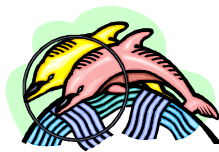
When: Wednesday 21st October @ Resource Centre
