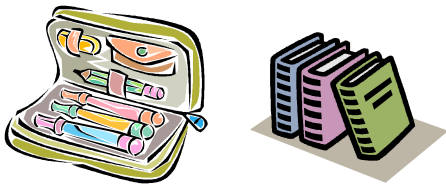
STUDENT ATTENDANCE
