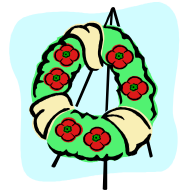

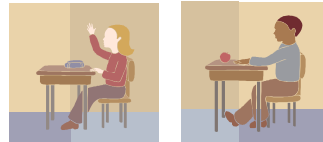
TOWN ANZAC DAY SERVICE

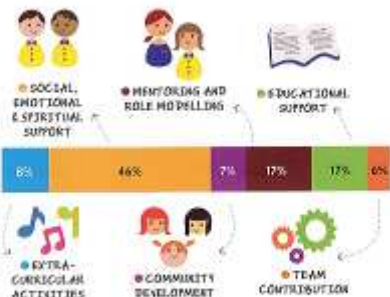

Chaplains promote positive spirituality in all that they do, providing opportunities for students, staff and families to take advantage of spiritual strengths, assets and resources available to them.

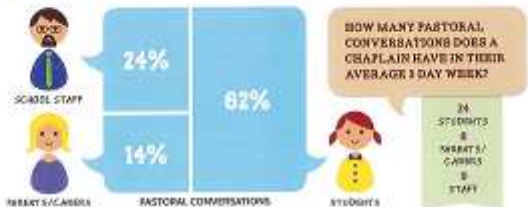

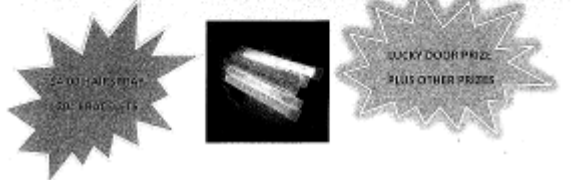
