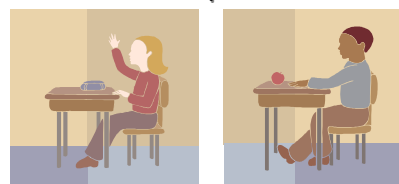

**Chappy Chatter with Chappy Jason  
Connecting with young people, part 2.**

When it comes to connecting with secondary students, quality time is still a big factor, but there are several more that really make the difference. As with younger students, you still need to find the point of engagement, be able to find some commonality in the conversation.
